



## Teen Artist of the Month Application

**In order to be chosen as an Osceola Center for the Arts Teen Artist of the Month, please adhere to the following guidelines.**

1. TAOM must be a student in Osceola County, Public, Parochial and Home schooled students are all welcome to submit an application to be considered for this program.
2. Application for submission must be legible and complete.
3. A minimum of 3 Printed photos of artwork and one 300dpi JPEG digital image provided on a CD are required for jury process. Please include your FULL name in the filename of the JPEG and clearly on the CD containing the digital image.
4. Teacher or Parent letter regarding the Teen Artists' artistic abilities, community or school involvement in the arts and general drive to learn more about the arts.
5. Supplemental copies of awards, letters or articles are encouraged but not necessary to be chosen for selection.

**Upon acceptance as a Teen Artist of the Month, student will be expected to present their work under the following guidelines.**

1. Provide 3-5 framed/matted pieces of artwork to hang at The Center for the period indicated in the month that they are chosen. (Include Title, Medium, Your Name on back)
2. Provide Artist Statement indicating inspiration, mentors and/or artistic process.
3. By submitting digital images of your work you are agreeing to allow said image(s) to be used in print marketing and news paper articles in conjunction with The Osceola Center for the Arts.
4. Attend art reception at The Center on the date provided for the month chosen.
5. Jury process is based on presentation, level of talent and support information regarding the Teen's strives for improvement as an Artist.
