1. Each Art Teacher will be able to submit 10 artworks.
Please no Class Projects (i.e. 10 pieces of the same subject)
2. Complete 2 Artwork Identification forms for each work. Cut and adhere to front lower right and back of artwork.
3. See page 3 for Artwork Identification slips.
4. **All artwork must be delivered to The Center on Wednesday, March 24th between 9am –1pm and 2 – 5pm.** Nothing will be accepted after March 25th. Please contact the Center if you have any special drop off requests.
5. **Artwork may only be picked up by teachers.** Pick up will be on Wednesday, April 28th.
6. Student Invitations to the reception will be given to Art Teachers when they bring artwork to The Center. Please make sure invitations go to participants as soon as possible. All students, teachers, relatives and friends are encouraged to attend the award ceremony *with or without* an invitation.
7. Students participating with work to be judged in the Student Show AND Arts Alive! must have both labels affixed to back of their artwork. Arts Alive! labels are supplied separately. Arts Alive ceremony takes place on March 30th separate from the Student Art Show reception.
8. **All framed artwork must be ready to hang and wired on the back, or work must be securely matted and adhesive hangers will be provided and applied by The Center.** No saw tooth hangers on heavy framed pieces. **NO POSTER FRAMES** with removable sides. **NO** “Home Made” hanging methods. **NO** Velcro. If you have any questions about framing or matting call Jules at 407-846-6257 x4 or email jules@julianadavidson.com. **Artwork that is not properly ready to hang — will be rejected, for safety of the artwork and patrons.**
